SALT LAKE ACTING COMPANY PRESENTS 10th ANNUAL CHILDREN'S PRODUCTION, PINKALICIOUS - THE MUSICAL

SLAC has provided arts access to nearly 20k students through its Title 1 Arts Education Program

[SALT LAKE CITY, UT, NOVEMBER 06, 2018] - <u>Salt Lake Acting Company</u> (SLAC), Utah's leading destination for brave, contemporary theatre, proudly presents its 10th annual children's production, *Pinkalicious the Musical*.

Since 2009, SLAC has dedicated its holiday season to bringing professional theatre to Utah families and schoolchildren, particularly to K-2nd grade Title 1 students—historically the most under-served demographic in Utah in terms of access to arts education through field trip opportunities. Each year, SLAC hosts several thousand local children during exclusive student matinees, which provide young children with vital access to the performing arts.

"After the economic crash of 2008, SLAC found itself looking at ways to give back to our community, as arts funding was becoming scarcer," said Executive Artistic Director Cynthia Fleming. "The theatre would normally sit empty during December. Our then-Interim Executive Director, Nancy Borgenicht, realized the potential to inspire the next generation of theatregoers and to bring Utah families through our doors." Fleming continued, "The impact SLAC has been able to make over the past decade through this familyfriendly seasonal tradition and our Title 1 Arts Education Program is one of the finest examples of the power of theatre—and of SLAC—in our community. We're incredibly honored and proud."

Based on the beloved book by Victoria Kann and Elizabeth Kann, *Pinkalicious the Musical* tells the story of Pinkalicious Pinkerton, a little girl whose love of pink cupcakes finds her in the doctor's office, pink from head to toe! In the musical adaptation by the same authors, with music by John Gregor, the audience gets to meet the whole Pinkerton family, Dr. Wink, and Pinkalicious's best friend, Alison as they all help Pinkalicious understand the importance of healthy eating and the joy of embracing who you are.

Penelope Caywood, Artistic Director of the University of Utah Children's Theatre, returns for her 9th children's production at SLAC. She directs a cast that includes newcomers Fiona Hannan and Seth Foster, as well as SLAC alumni Micki Martinez, Shannon Musgrave, and Alexis Baigue.

In honor of the production, SLAC has partnered with <u>The Kings English Bookshop</u> to create a pop-up *Pinkalicious* store in the SLAC lobby. An array of *Pinkalicious* books are available and can be purchased alongside show tickets.

SLAC is also proud to serve as a donation station for Washington Elementary this holiday season. During performances of *Pinkalicious the Musical*, audience members are encouraged to give to students-in-need. Requested (unwrapped) items include: jewelry, hair supplies, sporting equipment, slime, playdough, board games, coloring books, dolls, Barbies, sports team clothing, Minecraft items, remote control vehicles, bikes, skateboards, and gift cards.
